



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How many artworks can I submit?

Entrants can submit only one artwork.

What is the age requirements for entry?

The Prize is open to young artists aged between 12-21 years (excluding primary school children).

What artwork mediums do you accept?

Submitted artworks can be in a range of media including; drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, installation, textile and video.

Do I have to live in Mosman to enter?

No, the Prize is open to young artists living throughout Australia. However, please note all entries need to be received by the Gallery on Tuesday 30 April 2019.

How much does it cost to enter?

The entry fee is \$10.00 (incl. GST). If an artwork is not selected for exhibition, the entry fee is NOT refundable. The entry fee must be paid in person on the receipting day, Tuesday 30 April.

What size artworks do you accept?

2 metres² .i.e. 1 metre x 2 metres or 1.50 metres x 1.33 metres. Not 2 metres x 2 metres which is 4 metres² and over the size limit.

Can I submit an unframed artwork on paper?

If your artwork on paper (e.g. drawing, print or photograph) is not framed it must be mounted on foam core board which is a lightweight material available from art supply stores and some office supply stores.

My artwork has multiple parts. Can I enter?

Yes, as long as together the total area does not exceed the maximum size of 2 metres² .

I would like to enter a video piece. What format should the video be in?

The video should be submitted on a USB and should be no longer than 10 minutes.

I can't make it into the Gallery on Tuesday 30 April. Can I bring my artwork to the Gallery another time?

No, every artwork must arrive on Tuesday 30 April (8.30am-6pm) with two printed copies of the online entry form (confirmation email) in order for your artwork to be ready for judging. You can arrange a family member, teacher or friend to deliver the artwork on your behalf.

How do I print the entry form?

Once you have completed your online entry form and have clicked on the 'submit' button, you will receive a confirmation email from the online registration website *Wufoo*. This email will include your online entry form. Please print two copies of this email, making sure all the details are legible.

Please do not print the completed entry form directly from the Wufoo website. You must first click on 'submit' and then print two copies of the confirmation email.

Should I attach the entry form to the back of my artwork?

No. Please keep the two copies of your entry form (confirmation email) separate to your artwork. However, all entries should be clearly labelled on the back with name of artist, title, price (if for sale), category entered, address and phone number.

When will I find out if my artwork has been accepted for exhibition?

Selected entries will appear on the Gallery [website](#) after 5pm on Friday 3 May.

When will the Prize winners be announced?

Prize winners will be announced at a Prize presentation and exhibition opening event held at Mosman Art Gallery on Friday 10 May, 6.30pm. Event admission will be \$10 per person, \$5 concession, \$20 per family. It is free entry to exhibiting artists and children under 12 years. Event invitations will be sent by email. Prize winners will also be listed on the Gallery [website](#) after the event.

When do I collect my artwork?

Artworks not selected for exhibition must be collected from Mosman Art Gallery between **Monday 6 May – Wednesday 8 May (10am-5pm)**. Selected entries can be collected on **Sunday 9 June (3-6pm) and between Tuesday 11 June – Thursday 13 June (10am-5pm)**. The Gallery will be closed due to the public holiday on Monday 10 June.

Artworks not collected during these periods can only be collected by confirming prior arrangements with the Gallery on (02) 9978 4186. Please also contact this phone number if your artwork is to be collected by courier. Artworks not collected will be disposed of.
