### ARTISTS OF MOSMAN: 2088

After a hiatus of one year due to Gallery refurbishment, the popular *Artists of Mosman: 2088* exhibition returns as the first show of 2013. Each year residents of Mosman as well as Friends and Volunteers of the Gallery, are invited to submit recent artworks in any medium and theme in celebration of Mosman's unique artistic heritage.

The Mosman natural environment has inspired generations of artists since the late 19<sup>th</sup> century. Tom Roberts and Arthur Streeton were among a number of artists who painted the area from camps at Mosman Bay and Little Sirius Cove. They established an artistic tradition which has been upheld by scores of artists, writers, and poets ever since. Other prominent artists who have been closely associated with Mosman over the years include Margaret Preston, Hilda Rix Nicholas, Nancy Borlase, Ken Done, John Caldwell, Imants Tillers and Kerrie Lester.

As Mosman continues to attract and inspire its artistic community, many of their creative responses can be seen in the annual *Artists of Mosman: 2088* exhibition. The exhibition includes painting, drawing, printmaking, textiles, photography, sculpture and ceramics, and many of the works are for sale. As part of the exhibition, two local artist led workshops will offer participants the opportunity to continue Mosman's artistic tradition.

Suzanne Alexander is one of the most accomplished painters of maritime subjects. This drawing workshop which takes place at historic Mosman Bay, aims to assist artists to capture the movement, vibrancy and energy of life at the bay.

Participants can observe and record a number of maritime subjects; the Sydney Harbour ferries coming and going; boats at their moorings, boat ramps and historic stone seawalls.
