

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I don't live in Mosman. Can I still enter an artwork?

To be eligible to enter a work for exhibition, artists must live in Mosman or be a Mosman Art Gallery (MAG) volunteer or Friend of the Gallery. If you wish to become a Friend of the Gallery you can find the membership form on the MAG website; http://mosmanartgallery.org.au/friends-mosman-art-gallery

I am not able to deliver my artwork to the Gallery on the Receipting Day (Wednesday 20 March). Can I drop it off at another time?

No, every artwork must arrive on Wednesday 20 March between 10am-6pm with 2 printed copies of the online entry form (confirmation email) in order for the work to be considered for the exhibition. You can arrange a courier, or a friend or family member to deliver the artwork.

How many artworks can I enter?

A maximum of two artworks per artist can be submitted.

What mediums do you accept?

Artworks may be submitted in the following mediums; painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, sculpture, ceramics, glass, jewellery, digital media and textiles.

Is there an entry fee?

No, it is free to enter

How do I print the entry form?

Once you have completed your online entry form and have clicked on the 'submit' button you will receive a confirmation email from the online registration website *Wufoo*. This email will include your online entry form. Please print two copies of this email, making sure all the details are legible.

Should I attach the entry form to the back of my artwork?

No. Please keep the two copies of your entry form (confirmation email) separate to your artwork. However, all entries should be clearly labelled on the back with name of artist, title, price (if for sale), address and phone number.

What is a D-ring and where do I buy one?

A D-ring is a triangular or D shaped ring with a screw that is then attached to each side of the picture or canvas frame ready for us to attach a hook and wire for hanging. You can buy them at the hardware store.

My artwork was created before 1 January 2018. Can I still submit for exhibition?

No, only works produced after 1 January 2018 can be submitted.

When will I find out if my work has been accepted for exhibition?

Selected entries will appear on the Gallery website after 5pm on Monday 25 March.

When is the exhibition opening night?

The official exhibition opening will take place on Friday 29 March at 6.30pm. Invitations will be sent by email.

If I am represented by a commercial gallery and my work is sold, what is the commission?

You should discuss it with your gallery and tell them that the commission is split 50/50 between Mosman Art Gallery and your gallery, and it is based on a 40% commission i.e. 20% to Mosman Art Gallery and 20% to your gallery.

When do I collect my artwork?

Artworks not selected for exhibition must be collected from Mosman Art Gallery between Tuesday 26 March and Thursday 28 March between the hours of 10am - 5pm.

Exhibitors must collect their works between Sunday 28 April (3-6pm) and Monday 29 April (10am-5pm). Works not collected will be disposed of.
