

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How many artworks can I submit?

Entrants can submit only one artwork.

What is the age requirements for entry?

The Prize is open to young artists aged between 12-21 years (excluding primary school children).

What artwork mediums do you accept?

Submitted artworks can be in a range of media including; drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, installation, textile and video.

Do I have to live in Mosman to enter?

No, the Prize is open to young artists living throughout Australia. However, please note all entries need to be received by the Gallery on Tuesday 27 April 2021.

How much does it cost to enter?

The entry fee is \$10.00 (incl. GST). The entrance fee is to be paid online via credit card, debit card or Paypal. If you are not able to pay online you can pay in person on receipting day, Tuesday 27 April, using an EFTPOS, debit or credit card. Please note that Mosman Art Gallery no longer accepts cash. If an artwork is not selected for exhibition, the entry fee is NOT refundable.

What size artworks do you accept?

2 metres².i.e. 1 metre x 2 metres or 1.50 metres x 1.33 metres. Not 2 metres x 2 metres which is 4 metres² and over the size limit.

Can I submit an unframed artwork on paper?

If your artwork on paper (e.g. drawing, print or photograph) is not framed it must be mounted on foam core board which is a lightweight material available from art supply stores and some office supply stores. Artworks may be rejected due to poor presentation.

My artwork has multiple parts. Can I enter?

Yes, as long as together the total area does not exceed the maximum size of 2 metres².

My work was produced prior to 27 April 2020. Can I enter it in the 2021 Prize.

No – only artworks completed after 27 April 2020 can be entered into the 2021 Prize

I would like to enter a video piece. What format should the video be in?

The video should be submitted on a USB and should be no longer than 10 minutes.

I can't make it into the Gallery on Tuesday 27 April. Can I bring my artwork to the Gallery another time?

No, every artwork must arrive on Tuesday 27 April (8.30am-6.00pm) with two printed copies of the online entry ticket, in order for your artwork to be ready for judging. You can arrange a family member, teacher or friend to deliver the artwork on your behalf.

How do I print the entry form?

The Trybooking website refers to the online entry form as a 'ticket'. Once you have completed the online entry form and payment, you will have the option to print the ticket immediately (click on the yellow 'Download Tickets' button) or you can find your ticket attached to the confirmation email. Please print TWO copies of the entry ticket.

I have submitted the online entry form but I'm not sure if it's worked. What should I do?

Once you have completed all the details on the 'Ticket Holder Information' page, agreed to the declaration and clicked on the 'Next' button, you are then taken to the 'Checkout'. After you have completed this page and clicked on the 'Purchase' button, you will then see a message on a new screen saying 'Transaction successful'. If you do not see this message, your entry was not successfully submitted. If this is the case, check that you have entered all the required fields (questions with a red asterisk).

If your entry form was submitted successfully, you will receive a confirmation email with a link to your online entry form ('Tickets'). If you do not receive the email please check your 'Junk' or 'Spam' folder in your email. If you still did not receive the confirmation email or are having trouble submitting the online entry form please contact the Gallery on (02) 9978 4186.

Should I attach the entry form to the back of my artwork?

No. Please keep the two copies of your entry ticket separate to your artwork. However, all entries should be clearly labelled on the back with name of artist, title, price (if for sale), category entered, address and phone number.

I made a mistake on my entry form. What should I do?

Do not submit another (corrected) entry. Please contact the Gallery on (02) 9978 4186 prior to artwork receipting day (27 April) and staff will make the necessary changes to the online entry form.

When will I find out if my artwork has been accepted for exhibition?

Selected entries will appear on the Gallery website after 5pm on Friday 30 April 2021.

When will the Prize winners be announced?

Prize winners will be announced on the evening of Friday 7 May. Details regarding this announcement/presentation will be released at a later date, pending the current Government COVID-19 health restrictions. Prize winners will be listed on the Gallery website.

When do I collect my artwork?

Artworks not selected for exhibition must be collected from Mosman Art Gallery between **Monday** 3 May – Wednesday 5 May (10.00am-5.00pm). Artworks which are selected for exhibition can be collected between **Monday 7 June – Wednesday 9 June (10.00am-5.00pm)**.

Please contact (02) 9978 4186 if you have arranged for a courier to collect your artwork. Artworks not collected will be disposed of.

I am not able to collect my work at the times stipulated above. Can I arrange to collect it at another time?

Due to the high volume of entries received each year and limited storage space within the Gallery, all works need to be collected during the dates listed above and in the Prize Terms & Conditions. You can arrange a family member, friend or teacher to collect the work on your behalf.
