1 Margaret Preston, *Wooden Bridge*, 1925
This work by Margaret Preston shows a beautiful bridge. Can you design your own bridge in the space above? What patterns will you use?

2 Margaret Preston, *Mosman Bridge*, 1927
People can get overly Sirius in these parts. It is important to tell lots of jokes and be as silly as you can. What is the silliest thing you can draw on the map?

3 Elioth Gruner, *Taylor's Bay*, 1913
Elioth Gruner's painting was made near Taronga Zoo. Lots of animals have escaped over the years so keep a look out! In 1972 a Himalayan Mountain Goat jumped the fence, but was caught eating biscuits at Balmoral Parkland. Can you draw a disguise on this escapee goat to help them blend in?



4 James R Jackson, *Sydney Harbour*, 1965
How many ships can you spot in James R Jackson's painting? Are there more on the harbour today?

5 Arthur Streeton, *Sydney Harbour*, 1895
Arthur Streeton painted at this spot so long ago there

were steam powered ships in his picture! What sea faring vessels do people use to get about on the harbour today? Can you name any? Draw your favourite!


6 Sydney Long, *Clifton Gardens*, 1905
Sydney Long painted here. Do you think he got his name because he painted Sydney for a long time? Or was he the tallest man in town? How long do you think it took him to paint his picture?



7 Ethel Carrick Fox, *On Balmoral Beach Sydney*, 1913
Can you walk like a penguin as you go past the Royal Australian Naval base HMAS Penguin? What noises do penguins make? Can you say your name in penguin?

8 Arthur Henry Fullwood, *View from Balmoral*, 1885
Can you draw your own *View from Balmoral* below?

What sort of house boat would you like to live on? Could you draw one on the map next to the other house boats?

12 James R Jackson, *The Spit Sydney*, 1935
This place is called Beauty Point. Can you draw a picture or write a poem about something you think is beautiful?
